

10. HIGHWAYS

The Clerk reported she had notified KCC via their website of many potholes in the parish and highways had marked up accordingly for repair.

The light near the Village Hall had been reported as out of operation. The Clerk had arranged for the KCC Highways Officer for this area to contact the Chairman to tour the Parish to discuss road/lighting issue.

A recent near fatal event at the entrance to Links Close, where a parishioner fell into a ditch, highlighted the need for increased lighting in this area. A request would be made for KCC Highways to resolve.

11. JUBILEE FIELD

Andrew Parkington Safety representative from Playdale had visited Jubilee Fields to review the roundabout. He confirmed that the roundabout was safe and no issues present. He would confirm by email his report.

The reinstatement of grass in the play area was discussed. The potential fall height from the top of the firemans pole precluded reinstatement of grass in this area.

Dog fouling on Jubilee Field was causing an issue. This had been reported to Shepway District Council. Latest rules were obtained and posted on the village website and education of dog owners would be undertaken. A link would be posted on the website for personnel to report dog fouling.
