Insured with the ROYAL INSURANCE COMPANY, LIMITED, for £ **100**
the sum or several sums thereby insured thereon.

The Government agree with the Insured (subject to the terms and Conditions printed
on the back hereof or otherwise expressed hereon, which are to be taken as part of
this Policy) that if after payment of the premium the above-mentioned property, or any
part thereof, shall be destroyed or damaged directly or indirectly by AERIAL CRAFT
(hostile or otherwise), or Shots Shells Bombs or Missiles from or used against Aerial
Craft, or by BOMBARDMENT by HOSTILE GUNS not landed on British Territory,
at any time before four o'clock in the afternoon of the **29th.** day of
October 191**8.** the Government will pay or make good all such Loss or
Damage within 30 days after it has been adjusted to an amount not exceeding in
respect of the several matters the subject of this Insurance the sums hereby insured
thereon respectively and not exceeding in the whole the sum of **ONE HUNDRED**
POUNDS.
