The Council then accessed the Planning Portal of Folkestone & Hythe District Council (FHDC) and screen-shared 20/1428/FH "Determination as to whether the prior approval of the Local Planning Authority is required for erection of an enclosed steel portal framed extension at Wills Farm, Wills Lane, Newchurch, TN29 ODT", which had been emailed on 1st October too late for inclusion in the agenda, with a closing date for comments of 23rd October. 2020-7-10	Playground equipment replacement / repair	The Clerk recapped the information he had emailed regarding complete replacement of the damaged Pull-Up Bars. T Apps stated another contractor had proposed a repair of the damaged post at a much lower cost. The findings of the Playground Inspection Report in July 2020 were also discussed. After due consideration the Council RESOLVED to pursue further quotes for repair. Proposed T Apps, seconded D Woollard	ACTION Clerk to approach known contractors for quotes on repair and replacement, and email these to Councillors, by 16 th October.
2020-7-11	Exchange of informal information	Councillors discussed further projects to be undertaken in the playground, including improvements to the fencing. Thanks were given to D Woollard's husband for installing the replacement litter bin by the stile to the public footpath at the Donkey Field. Further improvements to the look of the bus shelter were desirable. Councillors noted public disquiet at the shooting of birds near Brooker Farm at 5.30am one morning recently, waking people up. A Cragg reported on progress with 3 elements of The Spinney Airfield Memorial, and hopes to notify completion in due course.	ACTION Clerk to email FHDC again re bus shelter.
